

OSP 3 v 3 Tournament

TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. Each team must have 4-5 players listed on their roster and players may only appear on 1 team roster for the tournament. Teams are responsible for providing their own jerseys.
2. Teams will be placed in boys and girls divisions based on the grade they will be entering in the upcoming school year. (2022-23). There will be 4 grade divisions : 3/4, 5/6, 7/8, 9-12. Players can play up in a higher grade division. Players can not play down in a grade division lower than their current upcoming grade.
3. Both teams will warm-up at the same time prior to the start of the game. Only the teams scheduled to play at that time are permitted to be on the court for warm-up.
4. A roster includes 4-5 players. A game may start with a minimum of 3 players.
5. Each court will have a court monitor that will handle the scoring and any disputes during game play.
6. The first team listed will be the home team for the game.

GAME RULES:

1. A coin toss at the start of the game determines which team will get possession to start the game. The home team will choose the coin toss.
2. The ball will change possession after each scored basket. (No make it take it)
3. A field goal is worth 1 point. A three point shot is worth 2 points.
4. All jump balls go to the defensive team.
5. A ball that is out of bounds will be taken out at the top of the court.
6. After a scored basket, the ball must be checked by the defense and passed in by the offense at the top of the court. The offensive team will have 10 seconds to put the ball in play. If the ball is not put into play in 10 seconds, the offensive team loses possession of the ball.
7. The ball must be taken back behind the 3 point line on every changed possession. "Taken back" means both feet and the ball behind the line.
8. Shooting Fouls - Players will be given 1 free throw on any shooting foul (field goal or beyond 3 point line). Possession goes to the defensive team after the free throw is attempted, regardless if the free throw is made or missed.
9. Non-shooting Fouls - The offensive team will take the ball out at the top of the court. The ball must be checked by the defense and passed in by the offense.
10. Each team is allowed a 1 minute timeout during the game. Player substitutions are permitted during any dead ball.
11. The first team to score 12 points winning by 2, will be the winner. The win by 2 rule applies up to a max of 15 points. The first team to get to 15 points first will be the winner.
12. All games will have a 15 minute time limit. The team leading at the 15 min mark will be the winner. If the game is tied at the 15 min mark, an overtime will be played. The court monitor will flip a coin to determine first possession, with the home team choosing. The first team to score in overtime will be the winner.
